The Festival has, annually since 1965, conducted competitions for all age groups in the playing of musical instruments and singing.

It affords an opportunity for amateur talent, young and not so young, new and established, to display their skills in public, in an atmosphere both stimulating and friendly. Competitors regularly come from as far afield as Liverpool, Manchester, North Wales, Scotland, Cornwall and Ireland and the standard of music is very high.

Some win small awards, all certainly receive public approbation and they have the benefit of constructive advice and criticism from experts in their adopted form of musical expression. The Biddulph & Moorlands has now established itself as one of the best one-day festivals in the country, and the number of entries has topped 500.

For those who just come to look and listen, it is a day full of entertainment and interest, with four classes running simultaneously, a musical feast at very modest cost. You may move between competition rooms at any time to watch and listen to the various classes. Refreshments, available all day (9-00am to 7-00pm), are of good quality and at reasonable prices, so you do not need to leave the building.
